The Committee reserves the right to appoint other judges and to withdraw judging contracts and to combine groups. All dogs to be kept on leash at all times. Conditions attracting immediate disqualification are set out in Reg. 4 of Schedule 4 and Reg. 31 of Schedule 3.

INTERNATIONAL JUDGES CV'S:

Kim Leblanc (Canada)



I was born with a dog at my side and at the age of 16, my Mom and I decided we wanted to have a kennel, went looking at Golden Retrievers and came home with a Siberian, the birth of Snowmist Siberians, the rest is history. Over the years, I have been involved in many different aspects of dogs including competitive sled dog racing, a short stint as a professional handler and several years as a director for the Canadian Kennel Club. Had the pleasure of handling different breeds - Samoyeds, Alaskan's, Std Poodles, Great Pyrenees, Newfoundland's, Borzoi and Salukis. Snowmist Siberian's may be found around the world and have experienced considerable success. Perhaps the greatest moment for my Siberians was when Fizzy won the group at the WDS in Austria.

Judging was a natural progression for me as a breeder, an opportunity to meet new people, visit interesting places and to judge beautiful dogs around the world which has exceeded all my dreams. An honour to judge in my own country Canada, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, China, Columbia, England, France, Finland, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Lithuania, Macedonia, Malaysia, New Zealand, Poland, Spain, South Korea, Sweden, the Philippines, Thailand and the USA.

A graduate of the canine course "Dogs, A Hobby or Profession" created by the late Casey Gardiner. Included in this educational program is a course on structure which is based on a measuring process and I have used this process to improve my own knowledge and to help others understand what they see and on evaluating litters of puppies and grown dogs; conducting all breed measuring clinics as well as seminars on this topic.

Horst Kliebenstein (Germany)



I grew up with dogs as my father had German Shepherds and later Miniature Schnauzers (black). At the age of 16 I bought my first dog, a Great Dane and my first litter was in this breed. I now breed Basset Hounds, Wire Teckel Standard and West Highland Whites. Since 1969 I was authorized as judge for Great Danes and one year later for Basset Hounds and French Bassets. Since 1974 I was a Group Judge for the old Group 5 and 6. Since 1986 I am an all-rounder. I am President of the FCI Judges Commission, since February 1998. I have judged in many different European countries and in Australia, Argentina, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, South Africa, Kenya, Panama, New Zealand, India, Malaysia, Taiwan, Japan, Thailand, Philippines, Korea, USA and Peru. Most memorable moments are

judging all my now 17 world shows, the first invitation to Sydney Royal and my first time in South America.



Billy Henderson (Ireland)



I judge all breeds in groups 1 and 2 at F.C.I. shows including groups and am a Championship Best in Show judge in Ireland. I award Challenge Certificates in Dobermanns under the UK KC rules and judge Working, Pastoral, Utility, Terrier and B.I.S. at open show level in the United Kingdom. I also have had the honour of judging in Sweden and Gibraltar recently. In the show ring as well as being the Top Dobermann breeder in Ireland for many years and having bred many Champions, including Best of Breed at Cruft's, I have owned, bred or handled Champions in Dobermanns, Rottweiler's, Great Danes, Kerry Blue,

Saluki, Dachshund, Tibetan spaniels, winning many Best in Shows.
