Please note that by entering and attending this event and signing the KUSA Disclaimer, participants are agreeing to comply with any instructions issued by the COVID-19 Compliance Officers, and that the organizers have the right to request that any person leaves the venue at any time.

ACCESS

Access to this event will only be allowed through the through the main gate on Groenfontein Rd, Klapmuts.

An Access Control Point will be set up at the gate. This area will be manned for the entire duration of the event.

On arrival at the Access Control Point, all attendees will be required to be wearing a mask, to have their temperatures taken and hand in a completed and signed Disclaimer form. Access to the grounds and the venue will be allowed ONLY AFTER this has been done.

ATTENDANCE

Only organizers and their helpers, as well as dog owners, handlers and their assistants may attend. SPECTATORS ARE NOT PERMITTED. Arrivals and departures will be monitored and only 500 people will be allowed at the venue at any one time. In the interest of limiting and maintaining attendance at fewer than 500 people outside at any one time, exhibitors are urged to leave the grounds as soon as possible after completion of their classes.

SAFETY

All persons attending this event must wear a reusable cloth or sponge face mask, or a disposable surgical mask at all times, except when running while handling a dog in competition. Face shields are not acceptable. Any person not wearing a mask will be requested to leave the venue. All attendees must observe social distancing and, whenever feasible, maintain a distance of at least 1.5 meters between themselves and others with whom they do not live. Hand Sanitizer will be available at the Access Control Point as well as on the Judges' tables and in the toilet areas.

All exhibitor gazebos, tents and benching areas to be spaced at least 1.5m apart (and be a minimum of 1.5m away from the ringside). Exhibitors are responsible for regularly cleaning and sanitizing their own equipment and areas.

All equipment and furniture used at the event, including tables, chairs and office equipment, will be sanitized by the organizers before and during the event.

The prizegiving will be held outside at the club Gazebo after completion of the show. Social distancing must be observed during the presentation.

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND IF you have comorbidities, such as respiratory or heart disease, diabetes, TB, hypertension, etc., or if you are exhibiting any flu-like or coronavirus symptoms.
