Thereafter Baby Puppy Dog & Baby Puppy Bitch, followed by Best Baby Puppy and the Neuter Dog class.

No RAF or TAF dogs will be accepted.

Any incomplete or illegible entries, or those accompanied by the incorrect fees, will be returned. Any dog entered incorrectly in an age-restricted Class will automatically be entered in the Open Class.

No changes will be made at the Show.

Bitches in season will be allowed

The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

Puppies under four (4) months are not eligible for exhibition at the Show

Please take note of the following:

COVID 19: KUSA appeals to attendees at all licensed events to keep up basic precautions whenever possible to prevent a surge of infections, including:

- Wearing a mask that covers your nose and mouth.
 Masks are no longer obligatory outdoors, but must be worn indoor public spaces this includes the Organiser's Office at KUSA licensed events whether in a building or marquee.

All venues are limited to 50% of their capacity with an upper limit of 1000 indoors and 2000 outdoors (unless proof of vaccine or negative COVID test is required, in which case there is no upper limit)
