Breed Classes: Baby Puppy (4-6 months), Minor Puppy (6-9 months), Puppy (9-12 months), Novice (for dogs that have never won a 1st prize), Junior (12-18 months), Graduate (18-24 months), S.A. Bred, Veteran (Over 7 years), neutered, Open,

Order of Judging:

Best in show and Reserve best in show, followed by Best Puppy, Best Junior, Best Veteran thereafter Baby Puppy Classes and Neutered Dog class.

NOTE TO ALL EXHIBITORS:

Show Committee's right to cancel or amalgamate classes, amend the prize list or return entries or to change the Judge should this be required

Any dog entered incorrectly will automatically be entered in the Open Class. No changes will be made at the Show. Exhibitor's numbers will not be posted - they are to be collected on the morning of the show. The onus is on you to check that your entries have been received.

Please note that Baby Puppy and Neuter are not eligible for CC and BOB*

Exhibits are to be on lead at all times.

No other animal other than exhibits entered in the show are to be present on the show grounds

Only dogs with a KUSA Registration Number are eligible to enter shows and those dogs which have been given showing dispensation from the KUSA office for these show

Only Members of the Kennel Union shall be entitled to enter dogs in their registered ownership in any Championship Dog Show licensed by the Kennel Union

Dogs under 4 months are not allowed to enter

Public Liability: In terms of Regulation 6 of Schedule 4: "All exhibitors are personally responsible for the control of their dogs at all times and shall be personally liable for any claims which may be made in respect of injuries which may arise or be caused by their dogs."

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are permitted

The mating of bitches in season within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

Conditions attracting immediate disqualification are set out in Regulations 7 & 31 of Schedule 3.

COVID-19 Protocols & Procedures will be observed at this event

- A maximum of 2000 people will be allowed at the venue at any one time if held outdoors, or 750 attendees if held indoors.
- All persons attending this event must wear a reusable cloth or sponge face mask, or a disposable surgical mask, except when running while handling a dog in competition. Face shields only are not legal. Any person not wearing a mask will be requested to leave the venue.
- All attendees must observe social distancing and, whenever feasible, maintain a distance of at least 1.5 meters between themselves and others with whom they don't cohabit.
- Sanitizer will be available at the Organizers' Office, on all Judges' tables, at ring entrances and in the toilet areas.

Please note that by entering and/or attending this event, participants are agreeing to comply with any instructions issued by the COVID-19 Compliance Officers, and that the organizers have the right to request any person who refuses to comply with a request or instruction to leave the venue. Any person found to be non-compliant may also be liable for disciplinary action under Schedule 1 of the KUSA Constitution.

The above Protocols and Procedures are subject to immediate change in the event of either the Alert Level, or the Government Regulations pertaining to COVID-19, being varied prior to this event.
