- The Show Committee reserves the right to appoint alternative judges, re-allocate Breeds and advise all exhibits entered, of an earlier judging time, should the appointed judges be unable to officiate or receive too large or too small an entry.
- Dogs travelling from a region infected with Rabies are required to have a valid inoculation certificate against Rabies.
- Bitches in season will be permitted for Breed Classes.
- Sufficient parking has been provided PARKING AT OWNERS RISK.
- All exhibitors, handlers & owners are advised that they and any exhibit entered in any event may be photographed for, by or on behalf of NATC for the use and possible publication of such photograph by NATC.
- The mating or whelping of bitches within the precincts of the shows is forbidden.
- . No animal other than an exhibit entered for competition or exhibition shall be allowed on the grounds, with the exception of registered guide dogs.
- Conditions attracting immediate disqualification are set out in Schedule 3, Regulations 7 & 31.

Exhibitors/Handlers are responsible for the control of their dogs and shall be personally liable for claims for injuries/damages caused by their dogs. All exhibits must be on leads unless otherwise instructed by the Judge. The show will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa.
