- 1. Show is run under the rules and regulations of the Zimbabwe Kennel Club.
- Class Starting Times are stipulated as per the above table. Classes following on from a previous class do not
 have a stipulated time and the onus is on the exhibitor to ensure he/she is present half an hour before a class
 MAY start. Should an exhibitor be late for a class, neither the host Club nor the Judges will be held liable for the
 exhibitor's exclusion from that class.
- 3. Competitors are reminded to produce Dog Record Cards for Obedience, Dog Jumping and Agility, Including Height Record Cards
- Exhibitors must complete the entry form in full, using details as per the Certificate of Registration issued by Zimbabwe Kennel Club. Failure to comply will result in any qualification received being withdrawn.
- 5. NO LIABILITY is accepted by the Club, or its Officers, for any act or omission which causes damage or injury to property, dogs, or persons within the grounds for the duration of the shows.
- 6. One separate entry form must be used for each dog; <u>multiple disciplines for the same dog may be included on</u> the same form. Incomplete entries will be returned & Club will not be held responsible for incorrect entries.
- 7. Full catering and bar will be available throughout the show.
- 8. Club does not hold insurance for damage caused to or by dogs present at this Show. Any damage will be the sole responsibility of the owner/handler/exhibitor.
- Dogs resident in Zimbabwe must be registered with the Zimbabwe Kennel Club. Dogs resident outside Zimbabwe must use the registration number of the country of domicile. RAF and TAF are not admissible.
- 10. This is an unbenched show all dogs must be under strict control at all times. Bitches in season will not be permitted to compete in any of the disciplines. Mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 11. Owners must carry valid rabies vaccination certificates for all entered dogs; these may be requested by the show hosting club.
- 12. BITCHES IN SEASON will be admitted for the breed show ONLY, provided they have been suitably treated, and thought should be given to other exhibitors.
- 13. RESERVE BEST OF BREED will be awarded. THE WINNER AND RESERVE in each Group will be eligible for Best in Show judging, please follow the directions of the Ring Steward.
- 14. PLEASE LOOK AFTER YOUR RING NUMBERS. ONE NUMBER WILL BE ISSUED PER EXIBIT FOR THE ENTIRE WEEKEND. Should your exhibit eat your ring number please call at the office for a replacement
- 15. Regulation 8 of the Breed Show regulations: "No animal other than an exhibit entered for competition or for exhibition only shall be allowed within the precincts of a Show except with permission of the Show Committee or its authorized Show Manager".
